The purpose of this report is to seek confirmation of the appointment of a Subcommittee to consider/hear any representations that might be submitted on the above review.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL RESOLUTION

At its meeting on 27 February 2003 the Council adopted the changes to the existing trade waste charging policy suggested by the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee and authorised the commencement of the special order procedures to notify the proposed changes.

PROCESS

In accordance with the requirements of the Local Government Act the opportunity has been extended to interested parties to make representation by Friday 4 April 2003 on the proposed changes prior to consideration of a confirming resolution at the 24 April 2003 Council meeting.

It is necessary therefore for a Subcommittee to be appointed to consider/hear any representations and is suggested that this function be delegated to the Trade Waste Charges Subcommittee, consisting of Councillors Denis O'Rourke, Chrissie Williams, Carole Evans and Megan Evans, that considered the original changes to the existing policy.
