

10. FUTURE DIRECTIONS FOR SAFER COMMUNITY COUNCIL NETWORK

The purpose of this report is for the Community and Leisure Committee to approve the establishment of a Subcommittee to formulate a submission on a discussion paper entitled 'Future Directions of the Safer Community Council's Network'.

The discussion paper outlines the Government's priorities for activity to reduce crime in New Zealand. The document outlines different models for consideration and feedback. Input is invited from interested parties.

In view of the need to provide submissions to the Crime Prevention Unit by Friday 30 May 2003 (5pm), the Community and Leisure Committee is requested to approve the establishment of a subcommittee comprising the Mayor, Garry Moore; Deputy Mayor Lesley Keast; and Chair of Community and Leisure, Councillor Condon. Councillor Keast is currently the Council's elected member representative on Safer Christchurch. This subcommittee's submission would be recommended to the Council meeting scheduled for 22 May. Council policy enables the Community and Leisure Committee to establish an ad hoc subcommittee of a limited duration.
