

16. DRINKING FOUNTAIN – SOUTH CHRISTCHURCH LIBRARY/SERVICE/LEARNING CENTRE GROUNDS

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The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's guidance in regard to its support of a competition with local high schools for the design of a drinking fountain to be located in the grounds of the new South Christchurch Library/Service/Learning Centre.

In determining a brief for the competition, the following will need to be considered:

- At the Board's 13 May 2003 meeting, the Community Advocate tabled a detailed design for a multi-purpose drinking fountain, which had been costed at \$4,000.
- Does a maximum cost need to be stated?
- The winning design will need to be professionally costed – by whom and how will their fee be paid?
- Will there be a competition prize? If so, ideas, please.
- Who will judge the competition?
- Publicity for competition and winning design.
