18.4 KERB AND CHANNEL REPLACEMENT PRIORITISATION PROGRAMME

Further to the information provided at the Board meeting on 18 August 2003, attached is the kerb and channel programme for the Board area for the new years two to five. While under the approved process the Board can request the reprioritisation of projects within the programme, there is very little scope to make changes within the Board's area. There are only four streets in the area in the programme because there is very little old style ditched channel remaining. In 2005/06 Sinclair Street and Wainoni Road are already committed because the work starts in 2004/05. Bower Avenue and Bridge Street are programmed in 2007/08.

18.5 NORTH EAST CHRISTCHURCH BUS SERVICE REVIEW

Environment Canterbury is currently undertaking consultation on a review of bus service routes in North East Christchurch. The closing date for submissions is 14 November 2003.

At the Board meeting on 13 October 2003, the Board decided that Board members forward any comment on the review to the Community Secretary by 7 November 2003 for collation in a submission to Environment Canterbury.
