

## 11. TRAVIS ROAD/TRAVIS COUNTRY DRIVE LEGALISATION

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The purpose of this report is to seek the Council's agreement to declare a segregation strip, legal road on Travis Road adjoining Travis Country Drive (see attachment).

### BACKGROUND

The Travis Country Estate subdivision on the north side of Travis Road between Burwood Road and Bassett Street has two access roads to Travis Road. One of the access roads, Travis Country Drive (West) has legal access to Travis Road and the other Travis Country Drive (East) does not have legal access because of a segregation strip adjoining it.

### PURPOSE

The legalisation of Section 1 on attached plan SO 327414 will give legal access across the segregation strip to Travis Country Drive (East) and correct the anomaly. The physical works have already taken place.

### RESOLUTION

The City Streets Unit supports the following resolution and recommends the land described in the schedule below be declared legal road pursuant to Section 114(1) of the Public Works Act 1981.
