

18. NEW BRIGHTON ASSOCIATION FOOTBALL CLUB - APPLICATION FOR LIQUOR LICENCE

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval on behalf of the Council, as landlord, to an application from the New Brighton Association Football Club to extend its club liquor licence from a six month licence to a full year licence.

BACKGROUND

The New Brighton Association Football Club has been based in clubrooms at the Bexley Reserve for many years. The Club has been operating a club liquor licence from 1 April to 30 September each year coinciding with the traditional football season.

The football season has become extended over recent years and the Club now wishes to have a liquor licence covering the full year.

APPLICATION

In seeking the extended liquor licence, it is considered appropriate to obtain initially the agreement of the Council, as landowner of the Bexley Reserve. The application would then be made to the District Licensing Authority.

The Club is requesting the same hours of operation for the all year licence, namely:

Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays	7.00 am to 10.00 pm
Saturdays	4.00 pm to 11.00 pm
Sundays	11.00 am to 7.00 pm

The Council's licensing staff do not have any concerns about the extension of the licence to operate all year.
