

18. PROPOSED NEW RIGHT-OF-WAY NAME

The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval of a name for a new right-of-way. Road and Right-of-Way name approvals are delegated to the Community Boards. It is important that approved names will not duplicate or be similar to existing names.

WAI/20000586 J Crowe and Taggart Family Trust 401 Sawyers Arms Road Waimairi Ward

This subdivision creates seven new residential allotments with access to Sawyers Arms Road via a new formed and sealed right of way. (Refer **attached** plan.) The subdivision is very close to completion and a name is required as there are insufficient numbers available on Sawyers Arms Road. The developer has been unable to think of a suitable name and has asked the Council to supply a name.

Two names are submitted for the Board's consideration.

The first option is **Orissa Lane**. Fifty years ago, the landowners in the location of the subdivision were Orissa Gardens Limited. This company no longer appears in either the Companies Office register, or telephone directory. The second option is **Higham Lane**. The Higham family were landowners spread throughout the Papanui and Harewood areas. A William Higham is listed on the electoral roll of 1865 as owning twenty acres on Harewood Road. Several members of the Higham family are still resident in Sawyers Arms Road, Highsted Road and Harewood Road today.
