

22. ST ASAPH STREET MOBILITY PARKS

The purpose of this report is to seek approval for two parking spaces outside Sport Canterbury at 70 St Asaph Street to be restricted to “Holders of Mobility Cards Only”.

Sport Canterbury is running a number of activities for people with disabilities. They are in the process of extending the opportunities for people with disabilities to become more active. Their building has an access for wheelchairs but unfortunately there is seldom parking spaces within acceptable distances from this access. It is therefore proposed to install two marked parking spaces for holders of mobility cards only, adjacent to the wheelchair entrance.

The next door business has been approached and is in agreement with this proposal. He runs a car sales business inside a large building where all his customers drive in, and there is plenty of space available.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to “Holders of Mobility Cards Only Time Limit 30 Minutes” on the south side of St Asaph Street commencing at a point 71.5 metres from its intersection with Antigua Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
