The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval to consult with the community on the next stage of the proposed work on Taylors Mistake Road. A concept plan of the proposed work will be tabled at the Board meeting.

## **BACKGROUND**

In 2000/01 stage one of the construction of Taylors Mistake Road from the beach to the first bend was completed. Stage two from the first bend to next bend has now been completed.

## **DISCUSSION**

The next stage in the construction of Taylors Mistake Road is from the second bend at No. 211 to approximately No. 197. The end is staggered on each side of the road so the work can be mated in with the existing road.

The work consists of road with a six metre carriageway for two lanes of traffic and a footpath on the downhill side. Where it is possible, parking bays will be constructed.

There is a need to negotiate the removal of the existing garage on the bend opposite No. 199 and Council Officers will be working through this process.

It is proposed to construct this next stage in 2004/05 if community agreement can be obtained.

## CONCLUSION

This stage has not been communicated to the wider community and Council Officers recommend that the concept plan in the form of a publicity plan be circulated for public comment
