The purpose of this report is to seek the approval of the Committee for the installation of a 'P10 Parking Space' on Durham Street South near St Asaph Street.

BACKGROUND

A request has been received from the owner of Auto Sound and Security for improved access to parking outside their business. There is a seldom used motorcycle stand outside the business on Durham Street South and it is proposed to change this to P10 parking. In addition, the Parking Unit has been requested to increase the enforcement of the P60 parking spaces on the St Asaph Street frontage of the business.

CONSULTATION

The request has come from the business that the proposed alteration is adjacent to.

Staff Recommendation:	1.	That the motorcycle stand on the western side on Durham Street South, commencing at a point 3.8 metres from its intersection with St Asaph Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 6.7 metres be removed.
	2.	That a 'P10 Parking Space' be installed on the western side of Durham Street South commencing at a point 3.8 metres from its intersection with St Asaph Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 6.7 metres.
