6. LINCOLN ROAD: PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval to alter the parking restriction on the eastern side of Lincoln Road at Addington (see attachment).

Mr Cliff Tregold of Lake Chemist, 294 Lincoln Road, has requested that the existing 30 minute time limit parking in front of the chemist shop be changed to a 10 minute time limit. The adjacent shop, Halal New Zealand Limited, is also agreeable to this change. The 10 minute limit would better reflect the on-street parking needs for both of these shops.

The proposed time limit change complies with the Parking Strategy for Arterial Roads under Policy 5A as a fifth priority item, i.e. for "short stay private vehicle parking for business and retail needs".

The Parking Operations Manager supports the proposed parking restriction change.

Recommendation:

That the Board approve the changes to the following parking restriction:

- That the existing parking of vehicles restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the eastern side of Lincoln Road, commencing at a point 32 metres opposite the northern kerb line of Clarence Street South and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres, be revoked.
- That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 10 minutes on the eastern side of Lincoln Road, commencing at a point 32 metres opposite the northern kerb line of Clarence Street South and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
