The purpose of this report is to obtain Committee approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$500,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

RELEVANT CURRENT POLICY

This project forms part of the City Streets Unit's Capital Expenditure Programme for the 2003/04 and 2004/05 year and is shown on page 9.5.57 of the Financial Plan and Programme.

DESCRIPTION

The contract is for carriageway resealing of various city streets in maintenance area one.

Tender prices have been received as follows:

City Care	\$830,339.48
Fulton Hogan	\$931,193.54
Isaac Construction	\$1,025,537.02
Works Infrastructure	\$1,119,139.66

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$10,000 and the work is for a two year period.

The estimate for the work was \$820,000.

Frie van der Krabben of City Care has given an assurance that the work can be completed within this budget.
