14. GLOUCESTER STREET MOTORCYCLE STAND

The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the installation of a 'Motorcycle Stand' on the south side of Gloucester Street between Manchester Street and the tram tracks.

New Zealand Motorcycle Rentals and Tours operate from 166 Gloucester Street immediately adjacent to the tram tracks and Cathedral Junction development. They provide motorcycles for many tourists.

An existing motorcycle stand is now no longer suitable as it is squeezed between the tram tracks and the steal plates giving construction vehicles access to Cathedral Junction.

It is proposed to remove one parking meter to cater for the demand and install broken yellow "No Stopping" lines where the existing motorcycle stand is.

Recommendation:

- That the parking meter on the south side of Gloucester Street commencing at a point 43.5 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance at 5.5 metres be removed.
- 2. That a 'Motorcycle Stand' be created on the south side of Gloucester Street commencing at a point 43.5 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 5.5 metres.
- That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the south side of Gloucester Street commencing at a point 49 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
