

## 2. OCEAN OUTFALL PIPE ROUTE - HEARING OF SUBMISSIONS

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The purpose of this report is to advise the Committee of the submissions received from the recent consultation process on the Ocean Outfall Pipe Route.

Members will recall that at the 25 September 2003 meeting of the Council it resolved:

- “1. *That staff carry out consultation on the pipeline route for Beatty Street, to provide the Council with feedback from residents, to be taken into account alongside the outcomes of consultation with Jellicoe Street residents, to enable a decision to be made.*
2. *That a check consultation be carried out with Jellicoe Street residents.*
3. *That a report comparing the outcome of the Jellicoe Street and Beatty Street consultations be reported to the November 2003 meeting of the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee with relevant legal and technical advice.”*

A total of 138 written submissions were received as a result of the consultation process and seven submitters have also requested the opportunity to speak in person to their written submissions.

Separately circulated for the information of members is a booklet containing copies of the submissions received and a schedule of times allocated for oral submissions.

It would be appreciated if members could please bring these with them to the meeting on 14 October 2003 which will commence at 9am. Lunch will be provided for those members not attending the seminar meeting of the Community and Leisure Committee which is being held from 12 noon to 2pm.

The Committee meeting will be adjourned to allow members to attend this seminar and at present will reconvene at 2.40pm to hear the final oral submissions.
