17.5 TELEPHONES - NEW BRIGHTON MALL

Telecom has advised that based on the proposed changes in the New Brighton Pier area (the adoption of the Master Plan and the proposal to install security cameras), the request to install a payphone in the area can be reviewed.

The Council has previously requested a payphone at the eastern end of the Mall in Marine Parade, north of the Mall entrance.

The New Brighton Pier Liaison Team and the New Brighton Commercial Ratepayers' and Retailers' Association have confirmed their preference for this site.

Telecom has also indicated support for the installation of a further payphone in the shopping area of the Mall.
