

7. EVELEYN COUZINS AVENUE: PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

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The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the installation of a no stopping restriction at the head of the Eveleyn Couzins Avenue cul-de-sac, adjacent to River Road as shown on the attached plan.

A request has been received from a resident that a no stopping restriction be put in place as it has been reported that parked vehicles are prohibiting turning and are blocking driveways and pedestrian paths.

CONSULTATION

Avebury House is located in the reserve adjacent to the cul-de-sac. This is a community centre for hire and is run as a non profit charitable trust. The community worker at this facility has requested that patrons not park around the cul-de-sac. However this practice is out of Avebury House's control, and therefore the community worker at the house also supports the proposal.

Staff

Recommendation: That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at all times on Eveleyn Couzins Avenue at the head of the cul-de-sac commencing at a point 23 metres from the property boundary between 255 and 253 and proceeding in a clockwise direction for a distance of 42.5 metres.
