

5. CLYDE ROAD, KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

The purpose of this report is to provide the Board with all the previous reports and outcomes of the Transport and Roothing Committee deliberations on the City Streets Unit capital works project to renew the kerb and channel on Clyde Road (University Drive to Creyke Road) and traffic management work for the fuller length of Clyde Road, from Riccarton Road to Creyke Road.

This project has been considered by the Transport and Roothing Committee on two occasions, 18 July 2003 and 15 August 2003.

(The reports referred to above have been circulated separately to Board members.)

Speaking rights had been granted, at both meetings, to Miss H and Mr R Thacker, who reside at 43 Clyde Road. Their property is situated on the southwest side of Clyde Road where it meets the Avon Stream.

On on-site meeting was held on Friday 29 August 2003.

Although this matter is recorded under the Transport and Roothing Committee report (clause 10.4) it has been brought out as a stand alone clause because of its importance.

Along with the information gained from the on-site meeting and the attached papers, members are asked to make a decision on moving this work forward.

Recommendation: That the Board now give consideration to the approving of the City Streets Unit plan for this Clyde Road work to be circulated for community consultation
