

### 3. CYCLE NETWORK PLAN FOR THE SPREYDON/HEATHCOTE WARDS

The purpose of this report is to respond to the Board's recommendation to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee that the Board receive an updated plan for all future cycleways proposed for its wards.

#### BACKGROUND

The Board experienced concerns during its consideration of consultation over a recent proposal to provide cycle lanes on Strickland Street in regard to the overall forward planning programme for cycle facilities and recommended to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee that :

*"Before any decision is made [over Strickland Street cycle lane provision] the Board receive an updated plan for all future cycleways proposed for the Spreydon/Heathcote wards."*

The Transport Planner for Cyclists and Pedestrians will present the current cycle network plan and the existing five year capital programme to the meeting.

In addition, representatives from the Council's Cycle Steering Committee will present to the Board the rationale for the current network approach and that for the individual route planning.

This will also provide an opportunity for discussion and response to members' concerns held on issues over cycling in Christchurch.
