

16. **CONTRACT NUMBER 03/04-18
THORRINGTON ROAD, WHERSTEAD ROAD AND WOOD BRIDGE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION**

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The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$500,000 authority delegated to Council officers.

RELEVANT CURRENT POLICY

This project forms part of the City Streets Unit's Capital Expenditure Programme for the 2003/04 year and is a Capital Output of the Financial Plan and Programme.

DESCRIPTION

The contract is for the construction of kerbs, channels, asphaltic concrete paths, grassed berms, stormwater drainage, landscape areas, minor shoulder restoration and full carriageway reconstruction for Thorrington Road, Wherstead Road and Woodbridge Road.

Tender prices have been received as follows:

Works Infrastructure Limited	\$790,094.71
City Care Limited	\$837,727.50
Local Construction	\$844,673.50
Calcon Asphalt Limited	\$948,833.75

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$60,000 and the work is for a thirty-one (31) week period.

The estimate for the work was \$848,600.

The total costs for this project is within the total budget of the City Streets' kerbs and channels renewal category of the five-year Capital Expenditure Programme.

RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved (refer attached). No significant changes have had to be made to the design shown on the publicity leaflet.

Gary Ikin of Works Infrastructure has given an assurance that the work will be completed within the specified time.
