The purpose of this report is to create a new bus stop in Durham Street adjacent to the Salvation Army Church. A consequence of the recent changes to the bus stop in Cathedral Square has been the re-routing of a number of bus services into and out of the Square.

This new bus stop which is to be located just to the south of Chester Street has the support of the Canterbury Regional Council and the Parking Operations Manager. The proposed stop will replace two existing P60 metered parking spaces.

Recommendation:

- 1. That a bus stop be created on the western side of Durham Street commencing at a point 6 metres measured in a northerly direction from a point opposite the northern kerbline of Chester Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 - 2. That the existing P60 metered parking spaces be deleted.
