The Committee received a report from the Environmental Policy and Planning Manager, updating progress on the Central City Bus Terminus/Interchange Relocation project.

The report had been referred to both the City Services and Central City Committees.

The Committee **agreed**:

- 1. That the Council endorses the "peripheral termini" concept for adoption in the future central city bus terminus/interchange relocation study.
- 2. That the Council establishes a sub-committee to oversee the further progress of this study, comprising three members from each of Central City, City Services and Environmental Committees and invites the Canterbury Regional Council to nominate three Councillors to be part of this sub-committee.
- 3. That the sub-committee firstly considers and recommends whether to pursue an off-street or on-street interchange, and secondly develops a brief for a project team to undertake further study of this issue (including a target reporting date of February 1999).
- 4. That Councillors Crighton, Evans and Harrow be nominated to serve on the sub-committee.
