

**1. PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION
AT 388 WAIRAKEI ROAD**

The purpose of this report is to advise of the advice received from the Parking Unit indicating that visibility is inadequate for vehicles exiting Farrington Avenue onto Wairakei Road, when a vehicle is parked on the west side of the intersection. Both roads are collector roads.

The Area Engineer has investigated the situation and found the sight lines for a driver of a vehicle turning right out of Farrington Avenue into Wairakei Road are inadequate. If the stopping of vehicles is to be prohibited on the north side of Wairakei Road, west of the intersection for a distance of eleven metres, the problem would be reduced.

The property owners at No 388 Wairakei Road would object to the loss of all on street parking on this frontage, but an eleven metre parking restriction would still allow space for one parked car.

Recommendation: That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the north side of Wairakei Road, commencing at its intersection with Farrington Avenue, and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of eleven metres.
