The purpose of this report is to recommend to the Council that the bus stop in Hargood Street be relocated.

In May the Hagley-Ferrymead Community Board approved the installation of a series of bus stops for the changes to the Bromley bus route. A bus stop was installed in Hargood Street and the owner of the adjoining property has become very upset. Discussions have taken place with residents further south in Hargood Street and they have agreed to the bus stop being relocated outside their properties.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the bus stop on the south east side of Hargood street commencing at a point 75 metres from its intersection with Clydesdale Street and extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres be revoked.
- 2. That a bus stop be installed on the south east side of Hargood Street commencing at a point 32 metres from its intersection with Clydesdale Street and extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
