## 5. CANTERBURY CAR CLUB TRACK HIRE CHARGES

At the July meeting of the Council the hire charges proposed by the Canterbury Car Club for the period from 1 July 1998 until 30 June 1999 for the use of their track and facilities by outside users were endorsed except for the public address system hire charges. The Council referred these charges back to the Committee for further consideration.

The charge of \$675.00 per day was ratified by the Council at its 24 July 1996 meeting, there being no increase since that date.

The present public address system was installed by the club at a cost of approximately \$25,000, the reason in part being so as to modulate the sound produced so that it does not cause a noise problem to neighbouring properties. The charge that was struck at the time was based on the cost that a Mr D Yoman charged per day for providing a public address system for the raceway, which had been \$675.00 for the previous year.

The public address system for the pit area is separate from the PA system for the spectators, and is included in the track hire charge to ensure proper management of participants.

**Recommendation:** That the Canterbury Car Club be authorised to charge \$675.00 per day for the hire of the PA system as ratified at the Council meeting of 24 July 1996.
