

## **10. ITEMS RECEIVED**

The Committee **received** the following reports:

**10.1 Promoting Physical Activity: National Developments  
and the “Active Christchurch” Programme** RR 8133

This report outlined national developments in recognising the benefits of physical activity and detailed a new local initiative being launched by the Leisure Unit in September.

**10.2 Coastal Wave Runup Study** RR 8149

The Parks Manager reported the results of the Christchurch Coastal Dune Wave Runup Study which was jointly commissioned by this Council and the Canterbury Regional Council to investigate the erosion of sand dunes during storms.

**10.3 Curator’s House Botanic Gardens** RR 8306

The Parks Manager outlined the process which will be followed to implement the Council’s resolution to seek alternative uses for the Curator’s House to provide greater benefits to both the Council and the wider community.

**10.4 Woolston Community Pool** RR 8140

Councillor Cox tabled two reports from the Woolston School and the Woolston Community Pool Secretary reviewing the pool operation for the 1997/98 season, expressing appreciation to the Council for its past support and expressing the hope that this will continue in future.
