The purpose of this report is to seek Council approval for a parking restriction of 30 minutes in Birdwood Avenue and Malcolm Avenue adjacent to the shops at this intersection. Council approval is required as Birdwood Avenue is an Arterial road.

A request has been received from the owner/occupier to install time restricted parking outside the premises on the corner of Birdwood Avenue and Malcolm Avenue. All day parking of vehicles from the nearby church is causing problems for passing vehicles being able to park short term to access these shops. Numerous funerals are held at the church throughout the week and this is also causing parking problems. It is noted from the shop owners request that the viability of suburban shops is dependent on short term kerb side parking.

To resolve this problem 'Time Restricted Parking' with a maximum of 30 minutes should be installed.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the south side of Malcolm Avenue commencing at a point 11.5 metres from its intersection with Birdwood Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the east side of Birdwood Avenue commencing at a point six metres from its intersection with Malcolm Avenue and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 24 metres.
- 3. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the east side of Birdwood Avenue commencing at a point nine metres from its intersection with Malcolm Avenue and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
