

4. CASHMERE HIGH SCHOOL – PILOT PROGRAMME FOR BEHAVIOUR MODIFICATION

The Board was requested to consider funding for a pilot behaviour modification programme at Cashmere High School.

The Council through its Leisure Unit budget, had provided \$10,000 for the pilot and the school was seeking a further \$5,000 from the Board to carry the project from mid November 1998 through to the end of the school year.

Dave Turnbull, Acting Principal, spoke on the project and advised of the benefits particularly to those students that had been failed by existing external providers.

The Board whilst extremely supportive of the initiative **decided**, that in view of funds being allocated by the Council, to decline the request and to recommend to the school that alternative funding sources be pursued.
