The purpose of this report is to reinstate the Recovered Materials Special Committee of the previous Council.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The terms of reference of the Special Committee were:

1. To oversee the operational establishment of the Recovered Materials Foundation Trust by 1 August 1997.
2. To oversee the establishment in 1997 of a glass processing system for Christchurch including a glass crusher and bottle washing/reuse plant. It is anticipated that the Trust will eventually take over this activity.
3. To oversee the development of systems to dispose of recyclable materials collected from the kerbside and elsewhere including development of appropriate reuse industries. It is anticipated that the Trust will eventually co-ordinate this activity.
4. To establish a budget for the period until 1.9.97.
5. To develop a business action plan for the period to 1.9.97 for the Trust. This Plan will reflect the Council's intention to work co-operatively with existing commercial operators which are meeting the Council's objectives.
