

**4. EXEMPTION OF HISTORIC BUILDINGS FROM CRC AIR PLAN PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE USE OF OPEN FIREPLACES** RR 8778

A joint report from Senior Planner (City Design and Heritage), Assistant Planner Heritage, and Principal Environmental Health Officer, suggested the exemptions which might be sought from the proposed prohibition on the emission of pollutants from open fireplaces for appropriate listed historic buildings.

The Committee **decided:**

1. That a survey of listed and other buildings with public profile be made to ascertain those buildings where a case may be made for consideration of exemption in any hearings on the draft Natural Resources Regional Plan, Part A: Air.
2. That provision be made in any submission to the Canterbury Regional Council to allow for future listed buildings with a public profile.

(Note: Councillor Corbett voted against this resolution.)
