

3. FENDALTON ROAD–‘NO STOPPING’ RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Council to consider the installation of a “No Stopping” restriction on Fendalton Road east of Makora Street as shown on the following plan.

In response to a request from local residents, the Area Engineer investigated the situation and found that sight lines for the driver of a vehicle turning right out of Fendalton Road into Makora Street are inadequate when a vehicle is parked east of the intersection. If the stopping of vehicles was to be prohibited on the south side of Fendalton Road, east of the intersection to the common boundary of 155-157 Fendalton Road, the sight lines would then be adequate.

This proposal has been discussed with the property owners of 157 Fendalton Road who are in favour of it.

Recommendation: That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the south side of Fendalton Road, commencing at its intersection with Makora Street, and extending in an easterly direction to the common boundary of 155-157 Fendalton Road.
