

2. HAREWOOD ROAD–PROPOSED ‘NO STOPPING’ RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to request that the Council consider extending the existing “No Stopping” restriction outside the Harewood School on Harewood Road to the east of the vehicle entrance to the school

A request has been received from Harewood School that the existing No Stopping restriction be extended four metres to the east in front of the Harewood Hall, to the position shown on the 1995 publicity plan for the school’s pedestrian facility. This will improve visibility for pedestrians using the pedestrian facility in front of the school.

The existing no stopping restriction in front of the school on both sides of the road, as shown on the following plan, also needs to be formalised.

Recommendation: That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the:

- (a) North side of Harewood Road commencing at its intersection with Waimakariri Road and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 39.0 metres.
- (b) South side of Harewood Road commencing at a point 5.5 metres to the west of the western boundary of the school and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 33.5 metres.
