

39. DR & MRS P J MULHERN OWNERS OF WAHI RURU – REQUEST FOR FUNDING

The Board considered a letter from Dr and Mrs P J Mulhern, the owners of Wahi Ruru which had recently received a Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board heritage award, requesting financial assistance towards the funding of a colour brochure about the property and the preparation of a brass plaque to be erected at the entrance to the property summarising its historic value.

The Board believed that this project required further investigation and wished to see the text of the proposed brochure approved by the Council's Heritage Planner. The Board was reluctant to support the funding of a brass plaque for the property as it understood that the NZ Historic Places Trust had standard plaques available to identify heritage buildings at a cost of \$35.00.

The Board **resolved** to defer this matter to the next meeting of the Board and to seek further information on this proposal.
