42. KERRS ROAD – NO STOPPING

The Board considered a report seeking approval for the installation of broken yellow lines along Kerrs Road in the vicinity of the two pedestrian refuge islands.

For the safety of pedestrians using the refuge islands, the parking of vehicles along portions of the road needs to be prohibited. This will allow pedestrians a clear passage from the kerb cutdown to the refuge island and good visibility of approaching vehicles. It will also enable cars to see pedestrians waiting to cross the road.

This matter has also been considered by the Burwood/Pegasus Board, which has made appropriate recommendations to the Council.

The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the west side of Kerrs Road commencing at a point 15 metres from its intersection with Dunarnan Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Kerrs Road commencing at a point 15 metres from its intersection with Dunarnan Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 3. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the west side of Kerrs Road commencing at a point 23 metres from its intersection with Pannell Avenue and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 4. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Kerrs Road commencing at a point 23 metres from its intersection with Pannell Avenue and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
