

30. VARIATIONS TO THE PROPOSED REGIONAL COASTAL ENVIRONMENT PLAN

The Board was advised that the Proposed Regional Coastal Environment Plan was publicly notified by the Canterbury Regional Council on 2 July 1994 and that variations to the Plan have been prepared subsequently by the Canterbury Regional Council. Two major variations are the rewriting of two chapters dealing with "Coastal Water Quality" and "Activities and Occupation in the Coastal

Marine Area" Chapter 7 and 8 respectively. In addition to giving consideration to the original submissions, new submissions have been sought by the Regional Council. A new submission was being prepared on behalf of the Christchurch City Council and input from the Community Board was welcome.

The Board **decided** that it wished to have input into the Council's submissions which were to be considered by the forthcoming meeting of the Environment Committee and appointed a subcommittee of Erin Baker, John Freeman, Liz McRostie and Aaron O'Brien to consider this input.
