17. COMMUNITY BOARD REPRESENTATION AND SUB-COMMITTEES

The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That a Community Affairs Committee be established, which will be a Committee of the whole with the same terms of reference established by the previous Board.
- 2. That the first meeting of the Community Affairs Committee be held on Thursday 17 December 1998, commencing at 4.00 pm, at which it will consider:
 - a) The suggestion of forming a Finance Committee of the Board.
 - b) The possibility of closely liaising with the Community Funding Committee (for discussion).
 - c) 1999/2000 Capital Works Programme Response to Community Board Proposals.
 - d) Objectives & Performance Indicators 1999/2000.
 - e) Appointment of Board members to liaise with residents' groups.
 - f) Membership of Neighbourhood Week Committee.
- 3. That a Community Funding Committee be established, with the following Board members being on the Committee:

Mr Phil Clearwater Ms Lynda Carter Ms Elizabeth Maunsell Mr Oscar Alpers

The Community Secretary to ascertain validity of appointing alternates for this Committee.

- 4. Mrs Carole Anderton was nominated as a representative on the Christchurch Beautifying Association Judging Panel.
- 5. Mr Oscar Alpers was nominated as a representative on the Port Hills Park Trust Board.
- 6. That all Working Parties be unpaid.
- 7. That the Chairperson of the Board be an ex-officio member of all Board Committees, Sub-Committees and Working Parties.
