# 1. WHARENUI SWIMMING POOL - MECHANICAL SERVICES HEATING AND VENTILATION

The Committee considered a report prepared by the Financial Adviser to the Leisure and Community Services Unit, which provided an update on the mechanical services (heating and ventilation) at Wharenui Swimming Pool.

This report and recommendation has been referred to the Annual Plan Working Party.

The Committee **decided**:

- 1. That additional funding be provided in the 1998/99 Capital Programme for Wharenui Pool mechanical services of \$141,250.
- 2. That application be made to EECA for an interest free loan of \$140,000 for the installation of a 140kw heat pump at the Wharenui Pool.
- 3. That negotiations be held with the Wharenui Swimming Club to seek an annual contribution, being a percentage of the energy savings from the installation of the additional heat pump.

# 2. WHARENUI POOL - FILTRATION UPGRADING

This report to the Committee explained the increase in cost over budget of the proposed upgrading of the Wharenui Swimming Pool filtration and sought approval for additional funding to allow the project to proceed.

The Committee also received a letter from Mr Colin Hill, Architectural Designer of R and A design (copy attached). Mr Hill was the designer of the Wharenui Swimming Pool.

This report and recommendation has now been submitted to the Annual Plan Working Party for its consideration.

The Committee **decided** that additional funding of \$80,000 for the Wharenui Pool Filtration be provided in the 1998/99 Annual Plan and that authorisation be given to accept tenders and work commence as soon as a closedown period can be arranged with the Wharenui Swimming Club.
