SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE FENDALTON/WAIMAIRI COMMUNITY BOARD

24. AURORA PERFORMING ARTS CENTRE TRUST - APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM TRUSTEE

Last June, the Council resolved that Councillor Margaret Murray and Messrs Brian Law and George Bellew be approached to act as community trustees on the Aurora Performing Arts Centre Trust.

Councillor Murray and Brian Law subsequently confirmed their availability to fulfil the role. Due to work commitments however, George Bellew has regretfully declined nomination.

The Trust has a number of procedural and operational issues that it needs to progress and therefore it is important that the Trust is able to commence its work now. The legal adviser to the Trust has indicated the desirability of having a full complement of Trustees (seven in total) available during this set up period. To achieve this, the appointment of Tony Gemmill, the incoming Community Advocate for Fendalton/Waimairi as a temporary Trustee, is recommended.

The finalising of the third community representative on the Trust can be followed up by both the Board and the Council during November and December.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the appointment of Tony Gemmill as an interim Trustee on the Aurora Performing Arts Centre Trust until December 1998, be confirmed.
- 2. That in November, the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board give consideration to identifying the third community Trustee and recommend accordingly to the Council meeting in December.
