

1. ESTUARY ROAD - BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to request the Council's approval for the relocation of an existing bus stop on the west side of Estuary Road. The bus stop currently stands outside 402 Estuary Road and will be repositioned outside 398 Estuary Road. As shown on the attached map.

Mrs P M Goldstone of 398A Estuary Road has requested the installation of a seat at the existing bus stop outside 402 Estuary Road. Mrs Goldstone and other elderly residents in the area use the bus service for transport to Burwood Hospital and have requested the provision of a seat. The owners of 402 Estuary Road disagreed with the installation of a seat outside their property, however Mrs Goldstone has agreed to the bus stop and a seat being installed outside her property.

The owners of the properties at 398 and 392 Estuary Road are in agreement with the relocation of the bus stop and the installation of a bus seat. The Canterbury Regional Council also agrees with the proposed bus stop relocation.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the bus stop installed on the west side of Estuary Road, in line with the property boundary of 402/404 Estuary Road be removed.
 2. That a bus stop be installed on the west side of Estuary Road in line with the property boundary of 398/398A and 392 Estuary Road.
