

16. PUBLIC HEARING ON DOMESTIC COAL BAN

The Board considered a letter from the Canterbury Regional Council, advising of a proposed public hearing on the question of a domestic coal ban for Christchurch. The letter invited the Community Board to indicate whether it wished to be represented at a hearing on the domestic coal ban or as an alternative wished to provide written comments.

The Board **resolved:**

1. To set up a working party to make submissions to the Canterbury Regional Council on the proposed domestic coal ban for Christchurch.
2. That the working party comprise the Chairman, Derek McCullough, Liz McRostie and Linda Rutland.
3. That the working party determine whether the Community Board should be heard in support of its submissions.
