16. PUBLIC HEARING ON DOMESTIC COAL BAN

The Board considered a letter from the Canterbury Regional Council, advising of a proposed public hearing on the question of a domestic coal ban for Christchurch. The letter invited the Community Board to indicate whether it wished to be represented at a hearing on the domestic coal ban or as an alternative wished to provide written comments.

The Board **resolved:**

- 1. To set up a working party to make submissions to the Canterbury Regional Council on the proposed domestic coal ban for Christchurch.
- 2. That the working party comprise the Chairman, Derek McCullough, Liz McRostie and Linda Rutland.
- 3. That the working party determine whether the Community Board should be heard in support of its submissions.
