

## 6. AVON-HEATHCOTE FACILITATION

A report from David Gregory, Canterbury Regional Council officer, detailed the progress made in respect of management options for the estuary and its environs.

His report was further illustrated by a series of overhead transparencies covering:

- The vision
- Issues of the Avon-Heathcote estuary
- Evolution of a strategy

and a document tabled entitled, “The Visions for the Avon-Heathcote Estuary”.

Questions were asked in respect of the following:

- The preferred management option
- What mechanisms might be applied to get estuary users to adhere to the plan
- The availability of management plan information prepared in the mid-1980s.
