## 5. RALEIGH STREET/LEACROFT STREET – PROPOSED BUS STOPS

In a report from the Area Engineer, the Board was asked to approve the installation of two new bus stops in Raleigh Street (a local road) and to recommend to the City Services Committee the shifting of two stops in Isleworth Road (a collector road) to service the new section of the revised Bishopdale No. 15 bus route.

The report indicated that the Canterbury Regional Council had made a decision to place the Bishopdale (No. 15) bus route down Raleigh Street after examining the route options available and consulting with local residents and City Council staff.

As referred to in Clause 3.3 of this report, Lisa Thomson of 20 Leacroft Street was in attendance and she presented to the Board expressions of concern on behalf of local residents indicating dissatisfaction as to the consultation process undertaken by the Regional Council in relation to the chosen route and that there were a number of matters still outstanding which the residents wanted the Regional Council to consider.

Also in attendance to brief the Board were officers from the Canterbury Regional Council (Jill Atkinson and Wayne Holton-Jeffreys) on the process of consultation undertaken by the Regional Council.

From the information presented to it, the Board came to the view that it would be desirable if the Regional Council were to undertake further consultation with the overall matter being further considered by the Board after this had occurred.

Accordingly, the Board **decided** that the matter lie on the table and that the Canterbury Regional Council be requested to undertake further consultation with local residents and report back.
