The Area Engineer submitted a report seeking the Board's approval for four bus stops in Teesdale Street and a recommendation to the City Services Committee for four stops in Roydvale Avenue to service the new section of the Burnside No. 9 bus route.

The report indicated that the Canterbury Regional Council had decided to extend the Burnside (No. 9) bus route down Teesdale Street and Roydvale Avenue after examining the other route options and consulting with local residents and City Council staff.

Also provided for the Board's information was the content of a letter from the Canterbury Regional Council to local householders setting out the basis of that Council's decision on the amended route.

Jill Atkinson and Wayne Holton-Jeffreys from the Regional Council, provided the Board with a brief overview of the consultation process that was undertaken.

## The Board **resolved**:

- 1. That the installation of bus stops at the following locations be approved:
  - (a) On the west side of Teesdale Street commencing at a point 17.5 metres south of its intersection with Tay Street and extending in an northerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
  - (b) On the east side of Teesdale Street commencing at a point 25.9 metres south of its intersection with Tay Street and extending in an southerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
  - (c) On the south side of Teesdale Street commencing at a point 49.5 metres east of its intersection with Deepdale Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
  - (d) On the north side of Teesdale Street commencing at a point 7.5 metres east of its intersection with Deepdale Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
- 2. That it be recommended to the City Services Committee that bus stops also be installed at the following locations:
  - (a) On the east side of Roydvale Avenue commencing at a point 88.5 metres south of its intersection with Homersham Place and extending in an southerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
  - (b) On the west side of Roydvale Avenue commencing at a point 31.8 metres south of its intersection with Homersham Place and extending in an southerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
  - (c) On the west side of Roydvale Avenue commencing at a point 45.0 metres south of its intersection with Wairakei Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.

(d) On the east side of Roydvale Avenue commencing at a point 98.8 metres south of its intersection with Wairakei Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
