8. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

81 MAIN ROAD, REDCLIFFS

Mr John Tweedie had requested speaking rights to express concerns over the location of a pedestrian island which had been installed outside his property in Redcliffs. Mr Tweedie expressed concern that a traffic hazard was created by this traffic island and that he was, in addition, faced with considerable cost to realign his driveway and to relocate his fence because of the position of the traffic island and asked if the Council could meet the full cost of doing this as he is at present faced with meeting costs of some \$1,500.

The Board **decided** to request a report and recommendations on this matter from the Area Engineer and Local Programmes Team Leader, Barry Cook, for consideration at the next meeting of the Board.
