

3. PUBLIC PASSENGER TRANSPORT STRATEGY

A report from the City Streets Manager, Christchurch City Council, reviewed the progress of the implementation of the public passenger transport strategy since its adoption by both Councils in June 1998, covering:

- shelters
- stop infrastructure
- traffic priority
- real time information
- parking policy
- park and ride
- cycle and ride
- light rail/rail
- electric hybrid buses
- promotions/initiatives
- super low floor buses

The Committee **resolved** to receive the information.

It was noted:

1. That no provision has been made in the Council's Annual Plan this year for the new type of Council bus shelters, due to the trade offs made for other passenger transport infrastructure, but a review of the following year's provision would be sought at the appropriate time.
2. The need for the new shelters to include panels for the installation of bus timetables is to be investigated.
