2. DEPUTATION BY APPOINTMENT HISTORY AND OWNERSHIP OF TEMPLETON FACILITIES

David Buist withdrew from the meeting for this clause.

Messrs David Pierce (Chaplain) and Alex Cooper (Chairman of the Welfare Council)were in attendance and provided the Board with background information on the Templeton swimming pool complex and Chapel of the Holy Family. They stressed that both the Chapel and the swimming pool had been donated by the community and felt that the residents should be consulted on the future of the facilities, and given the opportunity to retain these. Consideration should also be given to the ashes scattered around the Chapel.

The Board agreed that further discussions were necessary, and should involve HealthLink South, representatives from Brackenridge, the Templeton Residents' Association, the Council's Senior Facilities Adviser and the Property Unit of the Council.

It was **decided** that the Community Affairs Committee be requested to arrange a meeting of all parties interested in the Templeton Centre facilities.
