The purpose of this report is to obtain Council approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$1 million authority delegated to the City Services Committee.

The contract is for the construction of a bridge over the Avon River between Hulverstone Drive and New Brighton Road, and will form part of the Woolston/Burwood Expressway. This project which is a cost share with TNZ is funded over two years. The Council is acting as principal to the contract on behalf of TNZ, and will make payments to the contractor, recovering the monies from TNZ for its share.

All tenders received were conforming tenders.
