

**8. CAMPERVAN EFFLUENT DUMP POINT –  
CANTERBURY STREET**

The purpose of this report is to outline a proposal to construct a campervan effluent dump point. The Riccarton/Wigram Community Board has considered a number of options and the proposal for a effluent dump point at Canterbury Street was considered at its meeting in November. Traffic Engineer, Brian Neill, advised that this site is not now considered suitable. He has proposed that the Council negotiate with the owner of a camping ground (holiday park) where a campervan effluent dump point is already available. It would be necessary for the Council to gain tenure over the site to ensure its continuing availability to campervans.

- Recommendation:**
1. That a site in a camping ground be favoured by the Council as a campervan effluent dump point subject to the Council securing some tenure to the site (probably lease) and incorporating appropriate signage.
  2. That the City Services Committee Chairman, Councillor Denis O'Rourke, and Councillor David Buist have power to act in negotiations on appropriate sites.
