

6. THE ORBITER: RATIONALISATION OF GREERS ROAD BUS STOPS

The Committee appointed a subcommittee to review the recommendation to install a new bus stop for the orbiter route at 405/407 Greers Road. The Subcommittee visited the site on Tuesday 23 November 1999.

Although the subcommittee had not met since the site inspection other members of the Committee had visited the site with subcommittee members. The Area Traffic Engineer confirmed that the other sites (409 Greers Road and 401 Greers Road) considered by the Committee members could not be recommended due to issues of traffic safety and the difficulty drivers of buses would encounter entering the turning lane. It was the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board's recommendation that a bus stop be installed at 405 Greers Road.

The Committee whilst supporting the recommendation requested that staff consult with residents to do anything possible to alleviate any inconveniences which may occur from the siting of the stop.

Recommendation: That a bus stop be installed on the western side of Greers Road commencing at a point 22 metres from its intersection with Eastling Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres (405/407 Greers Road).
