

2. NEW BRIGHTON MALL AND NEW BRIGHTON BEACH - LIQUOR BAN

Senior Sergeant Hyland advised that each of the licensed premises situated in the New Brighton area had been canvassed. A paper summarising the exercise was tabled.

It was noted:

- Michelle Beckett, in conjunction with the Police, had prepared a media release.
- Rae Finlay (Turning Point 2000) to be contacted by Peter Mitchell concerning the outcome of this meeting.

It was **resolved**:

1. That pursuant to Section 709A of the Local Government Act 1974 the Council prohibit:

- (i) the consumption of liquor; and
- (ii) the bringing of liquor or empty liquor containers; and
- (iii) the possession of liquor or empty liquor containers,

in the New Brighton Mall (excluding roped off/trellised areas of those licensed premises described below as may be licensed by the Christchurch City Council:

- McCormacks Tavern
- Pieters
- Jacksons Café and Bar
- Waterfront Bar and Café
- New Brighton Workingmen's Club
- Esplanade Tavern
- Pier 121,

and New Brighton beach between the north and south ramps (including the part of Marine Parade between those ramps) between 9.00pm on Friday 31 December 1999 and 9.00am Saturday 1 January 2000.

2. The reason for the prohibition is the holding of the Dawn 2000 event between those times.
3. That public notice of this resolution is given in accordance with the Local Government Act.
